


After Hours Big Band





Dick Byerly and I lived somewhat parallel lives in that we were both farm boys who went to Land Grant colleges (Penn State for him, Michigan State for me) and pursued careers in agriculture, He as a Teacher, I as a Veterinarian. We were within a year or so in age, had children at about the same time and did some farming for most of our lives.

While we would see each other at meetings and events, the times that we could really sit down and talk occurred at the fair, usually in the office, usually late afternoon or evening. To paraphrase the Walrus from Alice in Wonderland, that was the time to talk of many things; cows, crops, projects, history...
